Day01 Arrive in Xi'an

Arrive in Xi'an, be transferred to the hotel. (D)



Day02 Xi'an

Climb the ancient **City Wall** and visit **Forest of Steles Museum** where precious stone carvings and sculptures are kept. Then, pay a visit to **Great Mosque** built primarily in the Ming Dynasty when Chinese architectural elements were synthesized into mosque architecture, and it is the largest and best-preserved one of the early mosques of China. Enjoy a characteristic **dumpling dinner** at a local restaurant. (B-L-D)

Day03 Xi'an-Mt. Huashan

After breakfast, drive to visit **Mt. Huashan**, 120km from Xi'an. Mt. Huashan is one of the five most famous mountains in China and is famous for its precipitous slopes. You will take the cable car to the **North Peak**. Climb the **Thousand-feet Stone Pillar**, the **Lotus Peak**, the **Yuquan Court** and the **Changjin Pavilion**. (B-L-D)

Day04 Mt. Huashan-Xi'an

Drive back to Xi'an and visit the digging site and museum of **Yangling Tomb** of Emperor Jingdi and his empress of the Han Dynasty (25-220 A.D.) on the way. (B-L-D)



Day05 Xi'an

Begin the day's activity with an once-in-a-lifetime viewing of the extraordinary

2,200-year-old **Terracotta Warriors** of China's first feudal Emperor, Qin Shihuang. On your way back to the city, stop at a mountain village and meet local residents. After lunch, visit the superb **Shannxi History Museum**, the best of its kind in China. Visit to **Big Wild Goose Pagoda** which was built in 652 A.D. It contains a large volume of Buddhist

scriptures which were obtained from India by the eminent monk of Xuanzang. (B-L-D)

Day06 Depart from Xi'an

Be transferred to the airport and prepare for leaving for next station. (B)
