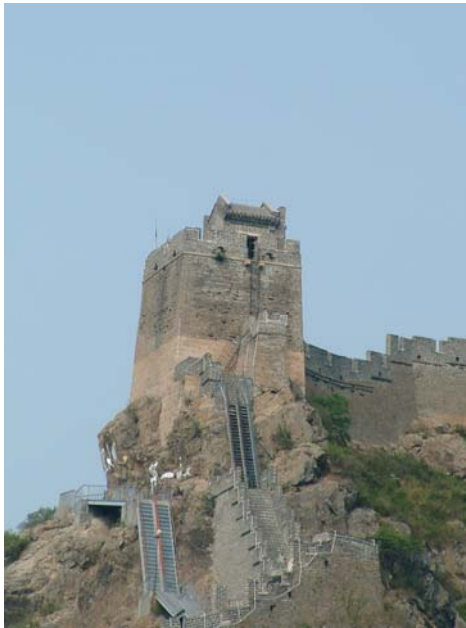
Jiaoshan Great Wall

Hanmen 10# tower – Jiaoshan Pass: 1587 meters in total

Hanmen 10# tower (58#) enemy tower: completed-preserved, extended to build ramp way from 132m south of Xiaochengtai Tower

Hanmen Pass, located 29 meters from Hanmen 10# tower, important point on strategy, the original tower is not existed today.

59#, wall tower, rebuilt in 1997



60# (Jiaoshan solid tower), completed-preserved, at the altitude of 243m, was first built in early Ming Dynasty. The tower is 9 meters high, the tower datum line is 17 meters to the bottom of the steep. Pu Fang was built later.

The Taiwan east side crenel comes between flatly north opens 0.6 meter wide wall mouth, two outrigger stone beams are settled under the mouth, which was used to suspend the rope ladder for up and down.

61# (Jiaoshan East NO.11 Tower), completed-preserved, was built in Longqing four years of Ming Dynasty (1570), there are war walls remaining on the outer side of the tower.

62#, 63#, basically completed-preserved

63#-64#, the great wall directs east from the southeast corner of Jiaoshan flat crest, then, down the mountain

64# (Jiaoshan Pass), some remaining in the valley, unrepaired

Steep-mountainous place wall



Sandaoguan Great Wall is 9.7km long in total, among the mountainous wall is 5200m long. This section is almost on the ridge of 300-500m above sea-level, very majestic. The passes were settled between the confrontational mountains. Mountainous place wall is the most character of this section.

65#-68#, mostly destroyed

69# (Sandaoguan Pass No. 12 Tower), mostly destroyed, only north wall is existed.

70#, wall tower, mostly destroyed

71#, wall tower, completed-preserved

72# (Taoyuan East No.13 Tower), hollow enemy tower, basically completed-preserved, was built in Wanli Sixth Year of Ming Dynasty (in 1578), the upstairs steps are made ingeniously.
